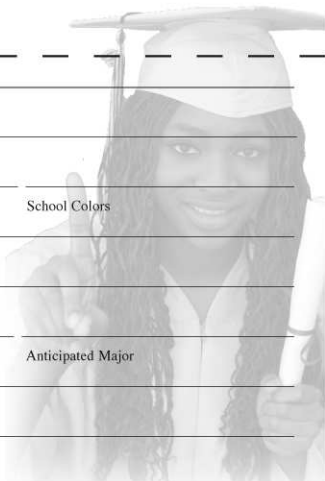

### Application Deadline:

Must be received or postmarked on or before **May 3, 2013**.

### Notification Date:

Only scholarship winners will be notified on or before May 10, 2013.

### Award Presentation:

All scholarship winners will be recognized and presented their scholarship award at the 18th Annual Graduation Celebration.

### Scholarship Eligibility Requirements:

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be eligible:

- Be a graduating high school senior of African or African American descent.
- Entering college as a freshman in Fall 2013.

Applicants must submit a completed application form including:

- A copy of an official high school transcript
- Two letters of recommendation (examples: teachers, guidance counselors, coaches, work supervisors, or youth advisors)
- A 500-600 word essay based on the theme "Education and Graduation: It's a Family Affair"

**Note** - All essays must be typed, double-spaced, in 12-point font, free of grammatical, spelling and punctuation errors. In addition, all essays will be judged on originality, clarity, and creativity.
